The Donnelly is now a peaceful holiday village sitting alongside an old timber mill. Bunnings Bros timber mill was once the most technologically advanced and original steam powered timber mill in the country. The work was hard and dangerous, with forest teams hauling timber into the Mill on Diamond T's - trucks which once carried US tanks. For many migrant families, working at the Donnelly was their first taste of Australia.
